REFLECTION QUESTIONS

Nicodemus was religious and respected, yet still lost-how does his story challenge me to look beyond appearances and examine the true condition of my heart?

Jesus said, "You must be born again." How do I personally respond to that command—do I see it as optional, confusing, or essential?

Ephesians 2:1 says we are "dead in trespasses and sins." In what ways has God brought me from spiritual death to life?

Ezekiel 36 and Jeremiah 31 promise cleansing and a new heart. How do I see God fulfilling those promises in my life today?

Jesus compared the Spirit's work to the wind–unseen but undeniable. What evidence of the Spirit's movement can I point to in my own life?

Psalm 51:10 records David's prayer, "Create in me a clean heart, O God." How can I make that same prayer part of my daily walk with the Lord?
